Literacy

In Literacy, we will ensure that children's KS1 skills are refreshed and secured before moving onto introducing them to the KS2 curriculum objectives. We will be doing this through, guided reading sessions, personal basic skills sessions and as well as through our usual daily literacy sessions. We will be focussing on the story of Cinderella as represented in different cultures to help children get to grips with the rags to riches topic. In our literacy sessions there will be lots of opportunities for children to listen and respond to their peers, secure reading and writing common exception words, consolidating phonetic knowledge and exploring how to use both familiar and new punctuation.

DT

We will be practising our sewing skills by designing and making our own pencil cases. We will be using simple patterns and templates to help us to create these.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the Hindu faith. We will be finding out about how they worship, how they express their beliefs and the importance of communal celebrations of Diwali and Holi.

History

In History, we will be exploring how the lives of the ancient Britons went from rags to riches in the Stone Age. We will be helping children to understand how humans moved from nomadic hunter gatherers to a life that is more recognisable to us today.

Values

Our values for this half term are friendliness and happiness.

Maths

In Maths, we will also be making sure that children are secure in their skills from last year before beginning to introduce them to the Year 3 curriculum. Our main teaching focus will be on number and place value, though we will be recapping other areas during our daily, fun, interactive maths meetings which will include loads of games and discussion. New learning will include comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000 and working with and representing these in different ways. We will also be learning how to count in multiples of 2, 3, 4 and 5, as well as in tens, 50s and 100s, and will learn to find 10 and 100 more or less than a number.

MFL
