



### Computing

In Computing, will be continuing our learning in coding, adding to our knowledge and using more complex events and commands to tell the computer what to do.

## Rebirth

### Science

We will be continuing to look at materials and their properties by learning how materials can be changed. We will be using words like squash, twist, bend and stretch to describe what is happening in our experiments.

### Values

Our value this half term is **honesty**.

### Literacy

In Literacy we will be focusing on stories about rebirth and exploring how a character can change and develop through a narrative. We will write our own rebirth stories after reading and learning 'Perfectly Norman'. We will continue to practise our handwriting and spelling skills daily. We will continue with our RWI sessions to practise our phonics and reading skills.

### PE

In PE we will be continuing our learning in Gymnastics where we will be moving onto balances and rolls before combining it all together.

We will also be getting ready for sports day by working as a team to practise throwing, jumping and running in team games.

### PHSCE

In PSHCE we will be exploring these 3 key questions:

**Who can help me in my community?**

**What is the same and different about us?**

**Who protects us?**

This will go into depth about what to do in an emergency and special people in our community.

### Numeracy

We are going to explore position and direction. Children will investigate quarter and three-quarter turns. They will then apply their knowledge of the motion of turns to the hands of an analogue clock to understand 'clockwise' and 'anti-clockwise' directions. Following this, children will look into measurement using capacity, volume and mass in different every day situations.

## Year 2 – Summer 2

### DT

In DT, we will be beginning a textiles unit. Children will be creating sock puppets and exploring using a running stitch, creating seams and decorating a design.

### Music

We are going to explore 'The Friendship Song'. We will be learning to play instruments within the song, use our improvisation skills and share and perform our own pieces.

### History

This term we will be exploring 'A Tale of Two Fires' in which we will look into the Great Fire of London in 1666 and the Great Fire of Newcastle and Gateshead in 1854. We will be comparing the two to find out what was learned and how the cities changed after these huge events.
